



Your puppy is guaranteed to be in good health at the time of delivery. A document from our veterinarian stating the puppy is in good health will be sent if your puppy is shipped. For the protection of the purchaser and seller, the puppy should be examined by a licensed veterinarian. If the puppy is declared in unacceptable health by a licensed veterinarian within 72 hours (Excluding Sundays and National Holidays) of the purchase/shipping date, he/she should issue a written statement of diagnosis, including a detailed description of all symptoms supporting that diagnosis, results of any tests performed, and the reason why he/she feels the dog is a poor health risk. These documents must be presented before the dog is returned. The puppy must be returned to us within 72 hours of the veterinarian visit. The buyer shall elect to keep the puppy or return the puppy to the breeder (at the buyer's expense) for a replacement puppy, provided that the puppy has not been injured or neglected.

If the buyer does not take the dog to a veterinarian within 72 hours (Excluding Sundays and National Holidays) from the date of purchase/shipping, this warranty becomes null and void.

As of the date of delivery, the puppy will have received proper vaccinations and de-wormings. You will be informed of these and should consult a licensed veterinarian for future vaccinations and de-wormings that may be due.

We DO NOT refund money, we replace the puppy with one of equal value from the same litter if available or another litter, only if our veterinarian is in agreement with the diagnosis of your veterinarian. Shipping costs are non-refundable. If the puppy is not examined by a licensed veterinarian within 72 hrs. no guarantee is given.

During the first year of the puppy's life, should he/she be diagnosed with any life threatening illnesses (not to include parvo virus, distemper virus, heartworms or any nutrition related disease), which is attested to by two unassociated veterinarians and the reason of illness is congenital, the breeder will replace the puppy. If the dog dies within the first year, the buyer will pay to have it autopsied to ascertain reason.

The animal must be diagnosed with the defect by 2 non-associated, licensed veterinarians by 1 year of age. Breeder must be notified at once at the onset of the problem, in writing, with a report from both veterinarians. Both reports must state the same problem. Seller's veterinarian will interpret the reports and if he agrees, then a replacement puppy will be given. The replacement puppy will be of the same value and sex of the first puppy.

Breeder guarantees a healthy companion pet but does not guarantee fitness for breeding or to be of show quality unless stated in the contract.

We, the breeder, are not responsible for any veterinarian bills acquired by you, the buyer.

We DO NOT refund money, we replace the puppy with one of equal value from the same litter if available or another litter, only if our veterinarian is in agreement with the diagnosis of your veterinarian. Shipping costs are non-refundable. If the puppy is not examined by a licensed veterinarian within 72 hrs. of purchase no guarantee is given.

Some disorders may be caused by environmental factors, for example: coccidia, giardia, kennel cough, cancer, demodectic mange, scabies, allergies and other autoimmune system disorders and these are not covered in this guarantee. This guarantee does not include injuries, fleas, mites, kennel cough or any other intestinal worms/parasites, as they are common in dogs and puppies. Our puppies are vet checked prior to leaving our kennel and you will be provided with his/her medical findings. This guarantee does not include uneven bites, undescended testicles, Class I to II insignificant murmurs, inguinal or umbilical hernias. We, the Breeder will not be responsible for Parvo, Distemper or Corona Virus after 72 hours of the sale, as these are highly contagious

diseases and they can be contacted immediately after leaving the Breeder. We will not be responsible for illness or health problems, which are diagnoses after this time period, except where stated in this contract.

Your puppy has been on a vaccination and de-worming schedule here and is up to date and these records will be provided to you. Please take these records to your veterinarian, as it is very important to continue with these vaccinations and wormings after you get your puppy home.

You, the buyer, agree to insure your puppy's good health and to keep our guarantee in effect by taking good care of the puppy and providing good food, housing and good medical care. As a responsible puppy owner/buyer you must provide your puppy with routine preventive care and all immunizations, administer monthly heart worm preventatives and annual physical examinations by a licensed veterinarian. Please remember that puppies are babies and they need lots of tender loving care!

This contract is valid for the original buyer that purchased the dog from MiTam Boxers. If the dog is transferred to another owner this contract is null and void. This contract is null and void if any of the terms and conditions are not fulfilled.
